Year 6 Maths & Writing Course (2 - 5 October 2018)

Students will develop understanding and fluency in mathematics covering number, geometry, measurement, algebra, problem solving, equations & formulae and survival skills for Year 7 mathematics. During the writing session, student will be provided with examples and key criteria to write a range of text types including news, reports, letters, discussions, interviews, feature articles and narratives. Students will then be required to compose text types in accordance with the criteria.
